Notes:

International students are required to live in the dormitory; all students need to pay a \$50 housing application fee; a \$150 security deposit and a \$20 mail box fee. The security deposit is fully refundable when the room is returned in good condition.

International students are required to enroll at least 12 units per semester (4 registered courses). The tuition discount covers a maximum of 4 registered courses. Students may take additional degree courses for an extra tuition fee at the standard tuition rate.

In addition, they are required to purchase health insurance here in the US.

International students are required to purchase student health insurance **here in the US**. Travel Insurance is not acceptable. Currently health insurance costs \$107 per month (calculated over 5 months for a single term). (This amount is subject to increase as it is **regulated by a health insurance commission of California**. UWest cannot control the cost of the health insurance.)

Finally, student's books, other materials, airport pickup, incidental expenses and travel costs are not included in the costs listed above and are the responsibility of the individual student. **\$26,000 and ESL is \$11,000**

Note: All Exchange students who apply for I-20 and F1 Visa, please provide \$20,050 for two semesters; \$10,018 bank verification for one semester for degree students; \$9100 for ESL program one semester.
