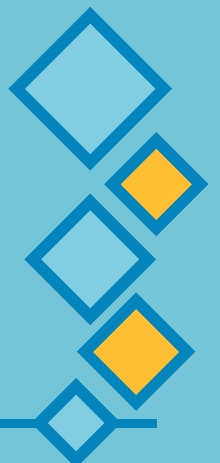

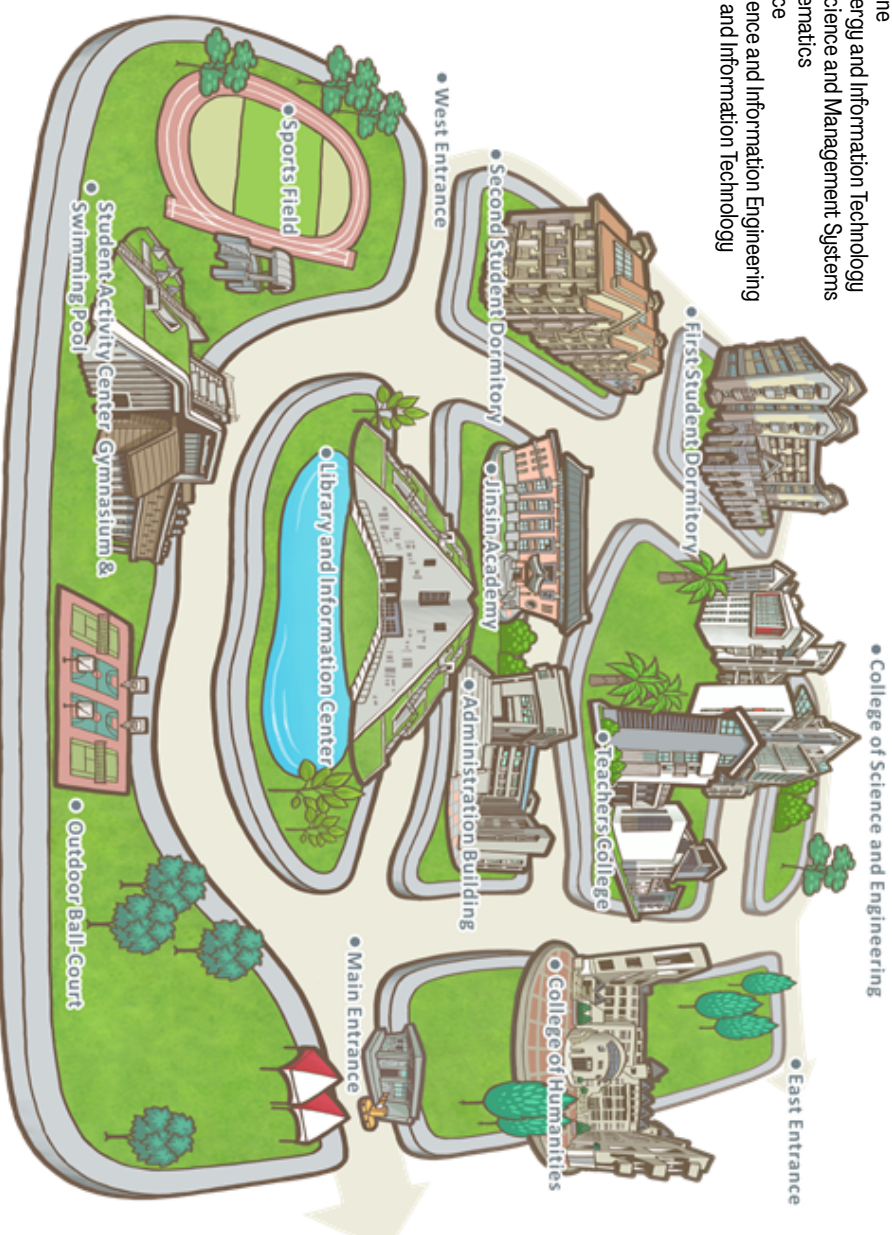

The Integrated library services and information services of Library and Information Center of National Taitung University have built many great public spaces: school history room, art gallery, lakeside lecture hall (192 people), extension education classroom (80 people), ergonomics computer classroom (60 people), interactive light wall, multimedia area (12 twin seats, 7 single seats), show room, learning commons (40 computers available, 3 surfboard style discussion tables which seats 15 people, 9 movable discussion tables which seats 22 people, 4 discussion rooms, 4 language learning carrels, n-th power space, research carrels (7 long-term, 2 short-term), study room (44 seats in self-study area, 42 seats in reading area), 4 seats in newspapers reading area, 180 seats in reading area, and 58 seats in resting area, for faculties and students to make good use of the resources.

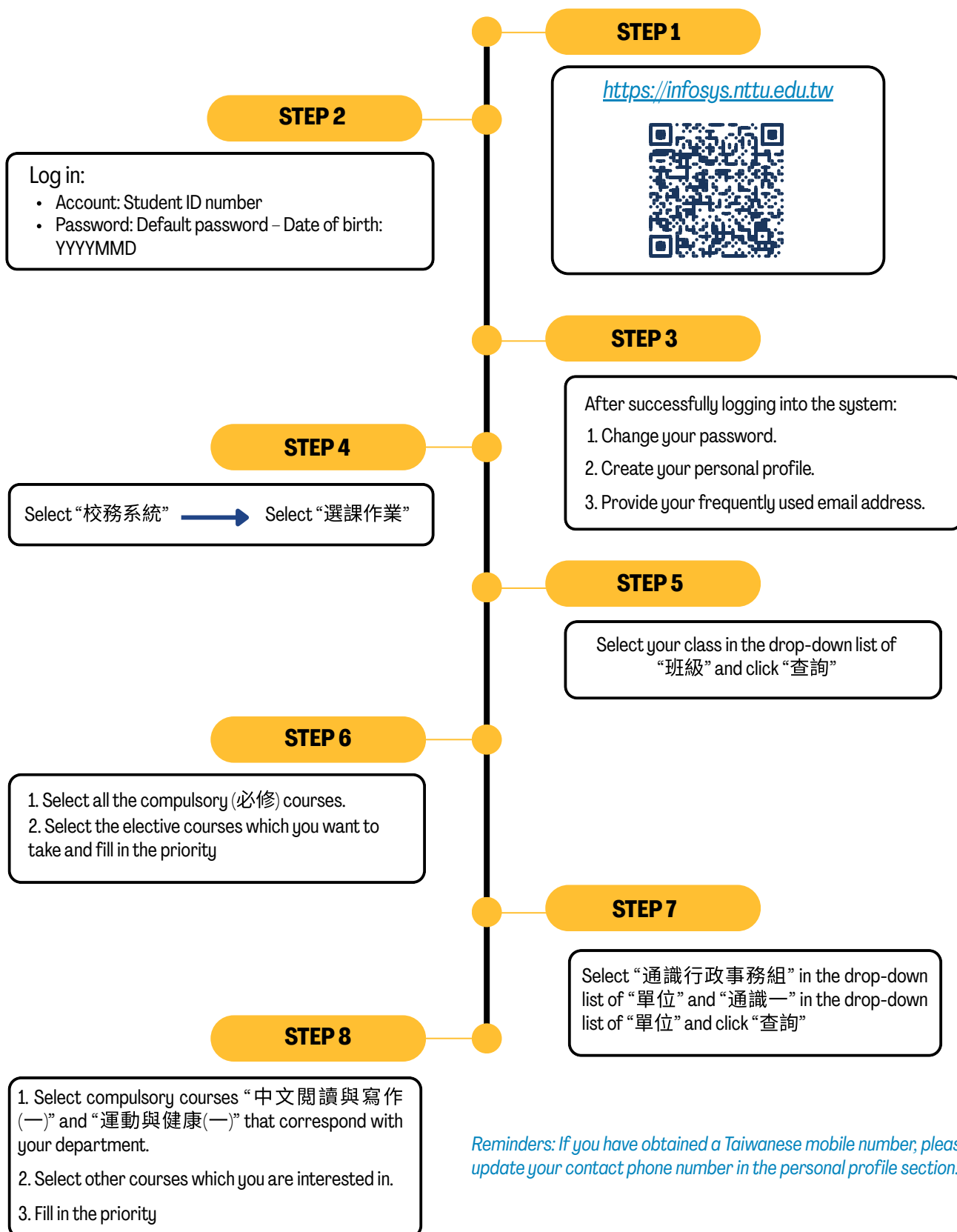

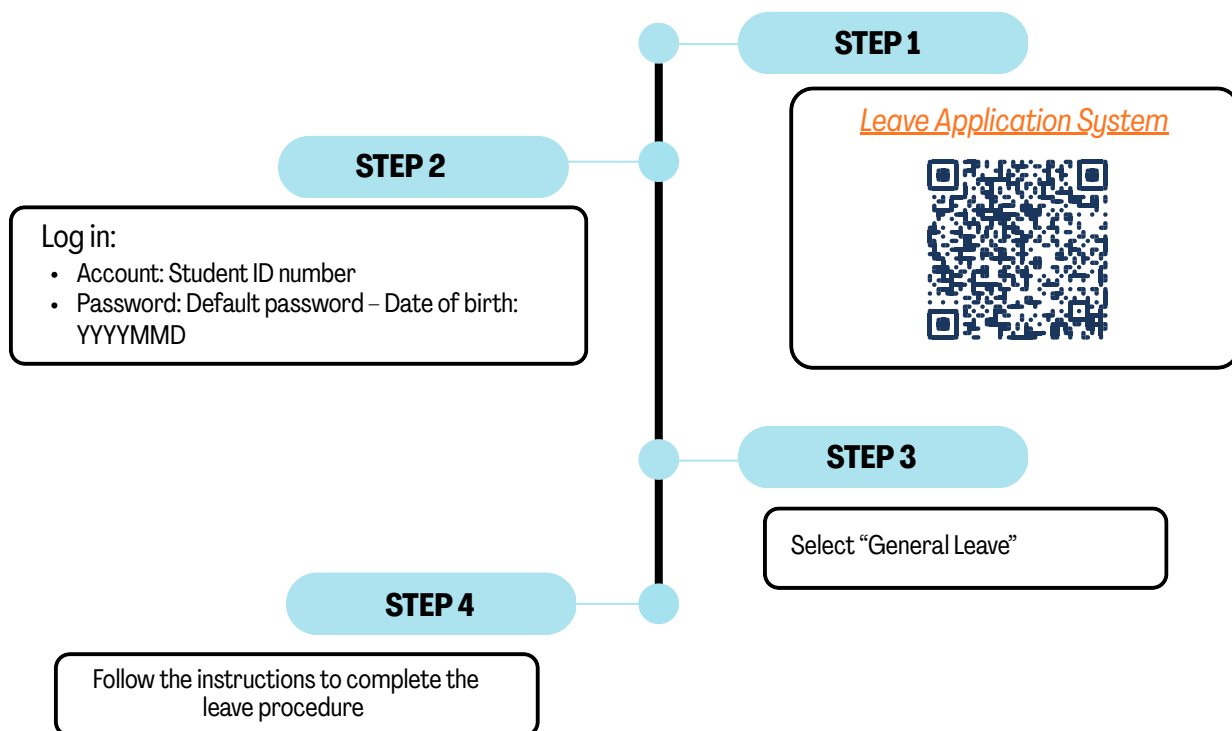

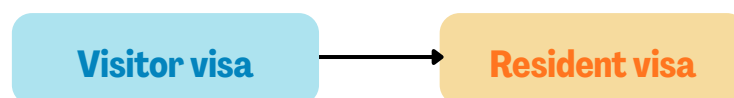

If you entered Taiwan on a visitor visa and intended to study for more than 180 days, please go to National Immigration Agency Taitung County Service Station and apply for extension. (If you were already issued a resident visa, you can skip directly to (II))

Applicants who enter Taiwan on a visitor visa which qualifies the applicants for resident visa application for the purpose of undertaking studies must apply for a resident visa 10 work days before the duration of stay expires.

A. Required documents and fees:

(A) Visa application form	Go to the website of Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry Of Foreign Affairs and fill in the online application form. Print out the visa application form with a bar code, and personally confirm and sign the application. The background should be white for the photograph
(B) Two photos	2-inch color photo taken in the last 6 months, affixed to the visa application form
(C) Passport	valid for at least 6 months with blank pages (original and photocopy)
(D) Original and photocopy of health certificate	Issued in the last three months (If you take the medical tests before coming to Taiwan, the certificate must be stamped and verified by a Taiwan Representative Office in your home country; or, if in Taiwan, you must take the medical examination at a designated hospital. Please refer to Centers for Disease Control's website for items required for health certificate and designated hospitals
(E) Letter of admission or registration proof from NTU	Original and photocopy of Transcript (student who came to Taiwan on a visitor visa wants to apply for resident visa for studying in Taiwan require an enrollment certificate, registration proof, and transcript)
(F) Original and photocopy of highest academic certificate (including diploma and transcript)	A notarized copy of the translation in Chinese or English is necessary if the original document is in a language other than Chinese or English
(G) Original and photocopy of bank letter/statement	
(H) Application fee:	NT \$3,200

(II) Resident visa → Alien resident certificate (ARC) / Extending your ARC

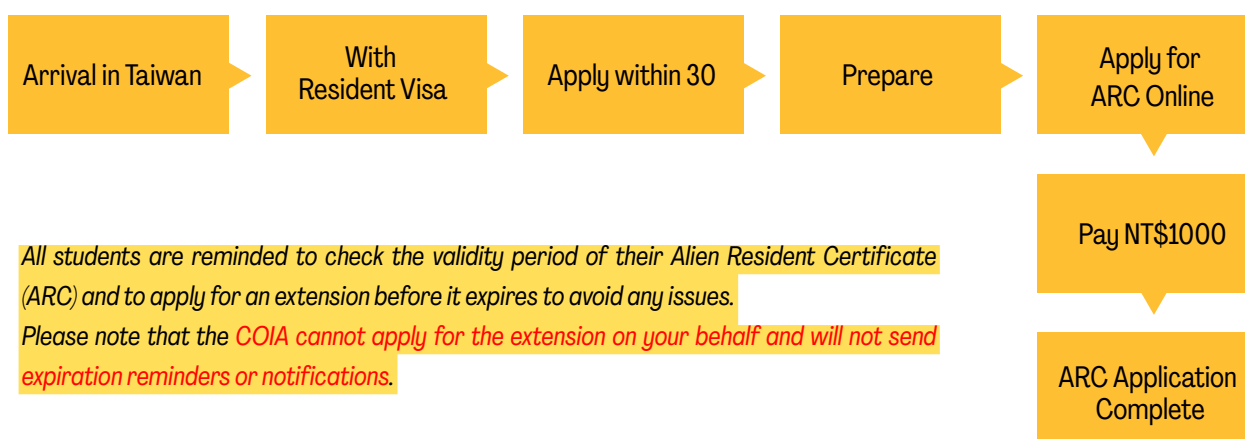
If you entered Taiwan on a resident visa or are already issued a resident visa, please apply for an ARC and re-entry permit at “[Students Online Application System](#)” within **30 days** after entry into Taiwan. The application fee for applying for the new ARC or extending the ARC is NT \$1,000 (one year), and the processing time for both of them is **7-10 working days**.

Note:

(A) International students have to apply for an ARC extension **at least one month earlier** than the expired date. If the ARC expires during the summer vacation (July, August, and September) and you need to leave Taiwan, you are allowed to apply for an extension online via uploading your round-trip ticket, related documents, and the Affidavit Letter provided by NTTU. Please be sure to complete the extension process and obtain the new ARC before leaving Taiwan.

(B) Students who did not apply for an extension by the due date will be subject to heavy fines and suspended their residence qualifications, and may be deported from Taiwan.

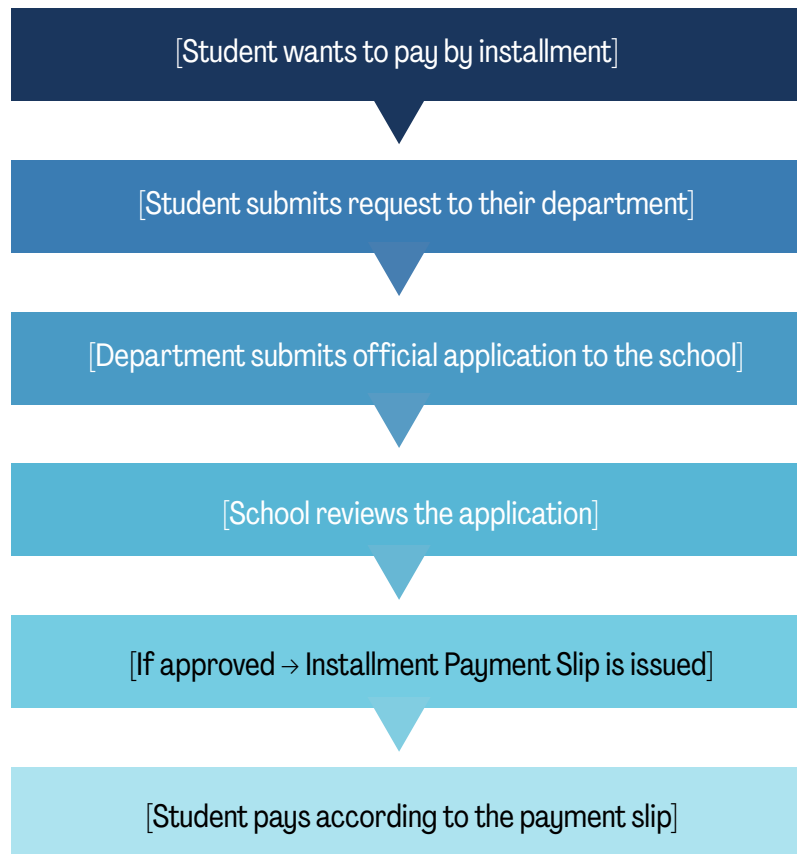

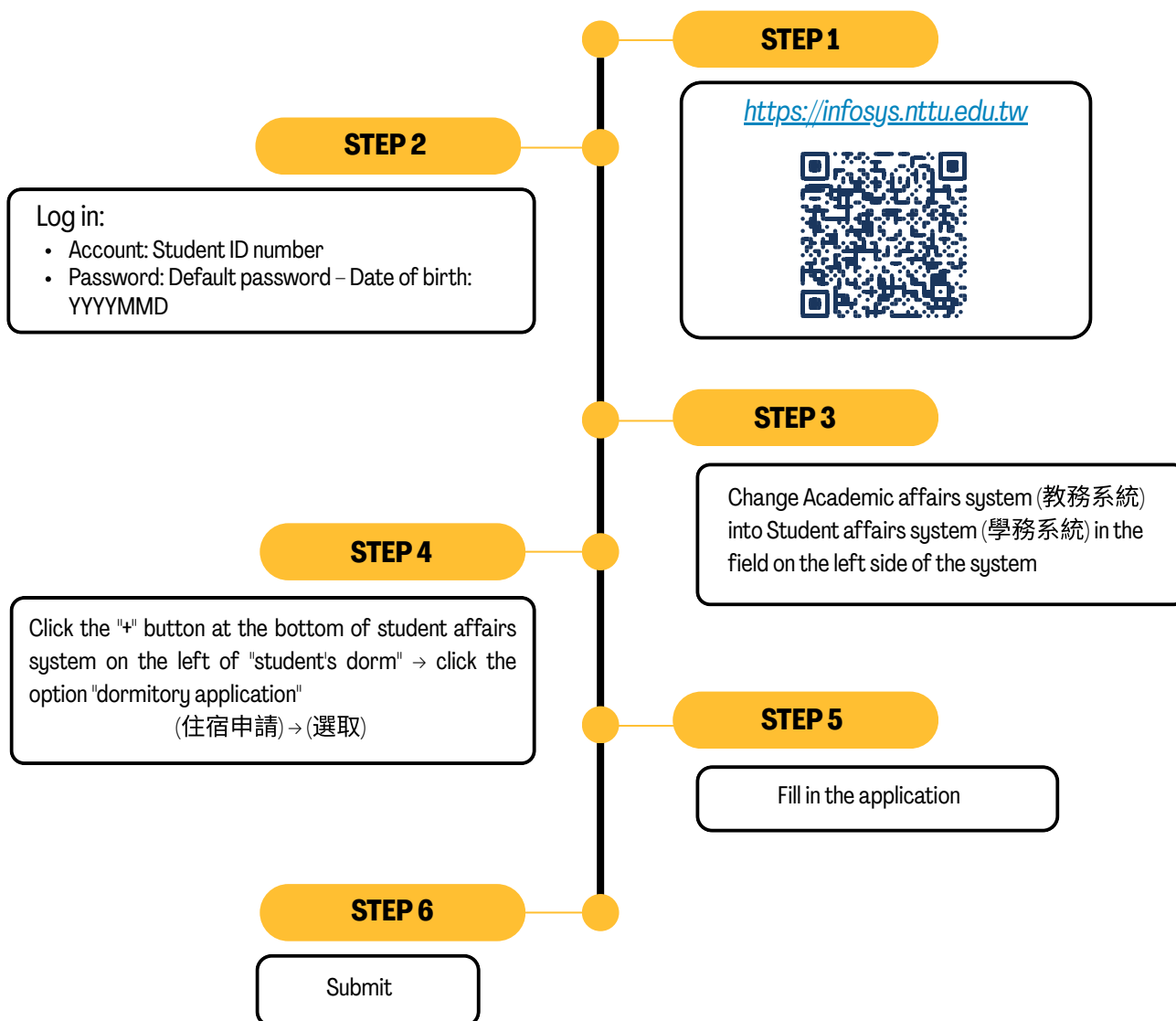
Once the school announces that the payment slip is available for download, students may bring the slip to their department office to apply for installment payment.

** Once you have paid your tuition for the semester, please take your student ID to the Registration Office to get the enrollment stamp.*

VI. DORMITORY

(I) How to apply for dormitory? (Do not apply for the dormitory via mobile device)



* Please pay in cash before mov into the dormitory.

Dormitory fee (Exclusive of electricity):

- Single Room: NT\$22,500/per semester (The First Dormitory Building)
- Double Room (The First Dormitory Building) / Accessible Room (The Second Dormitory Building): NT\$15,750/per semester
- Quad Room: NT\$10,125/per semester (The First Dormitory Building)
- Six-Person Room (Zhongxiao Building): NT\$6,000/per semester

Undergraduate students are assigned to four-person rooms.

Graduate students may apply for two-person rooms.

Students who need a single room for health reasons must provide relevant medical documentation.

Please refer to the academic calendar to keep track of dormitory opening dates and application periods.



VI. DORMITORY

(II) Dorm curfew regulations

Entry access control should be applied to each student dormitory starting at twelve o'clock midnight. However, those who have special causes and are approved by Discipline Section are not subject to the restriction.

(III) Dorm living regulations

* The following behaviors are prohibited for dormitory residents:

- A.** Occupying other beds, replacing beds, or excluding roommates
- B.** Stealing, gambling, drinking, chewing betel nuts, fighting, or playing mah-jong
- C.** Storage of hazardous materials, contraband in the dormitory
- D.** Allowing outside guests or vendors into the dormitory
- E.** Deliberately evading nightly inspections or staying out overnight without registration or entering the dormitory after closing time
- F.** Unauthorized access of electrical equipment without the consent of the school
- G.** Cooking, smoking in the dormitory
- H.** keeping any animals as pets in the dormitory
- I.** violating dormitory regulations adopted by Student Dormitory Management Committee
- J.** Other behaviors in violation of public health, environmental peacefulness, or public safety

** Regulations in Subparagraph Nine and punishments for breaking related rules should be communicated to Discipline Section for review. Those who are found to break rules from Subparagraph One to Three, or are in serious violation of Subparagraph Ten by dormitory supervisor or the Committee and Discipline Section should be expelled from the dormitory, and will no longer be eligible to apply for dormitory housing.*

** Those who are found to break rules from Subparagraph Four to Eight or Subparagraph Ten, and refuse to obey related directions given by the dormitory supervisor, instructor or the Committee should be expelled from the dormitory, and should not apply for a dormitory for one year starting from the date of dormitory withdraw registration.*

** Subparagraph Thirteen: Those who intentionally or negligently break school property should be reported by the dormitory supervisor or instructor to compensate the school within a specified period; those who do not compensate in a given time or intentionally damage school property may be expelled from the dormitory.*



VII. HEALTH CHECK AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

(I) Health Check

All newly admitted students are required to participate in the on-campus health check

On-Campus Health Check Information:

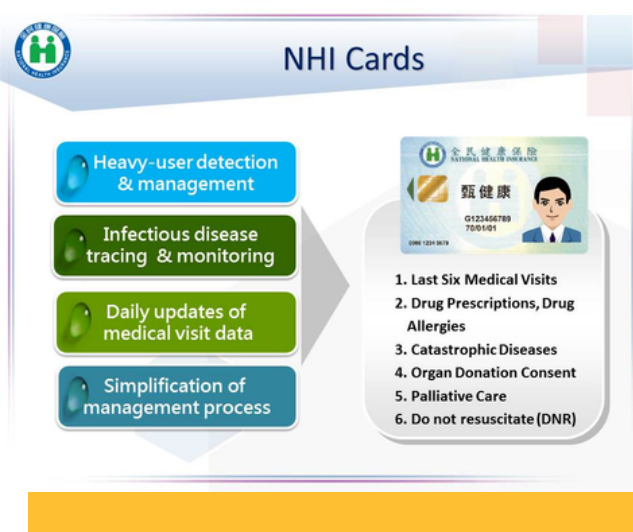
- **Dates:** September 12–13, 2026 (*Department Health Check Schedule: Please contact your department office or COIA*)
- **Location:** 1st Floor, Gymnasium, Main Campus (Jhihben)
- **Fee:** NT\$950 per person
- **Payment Method:** Pay the fee in cash directly to the designated hospital staff on the day of your health check.
- **On-campus Health Check Form (Attachment 1):** *Please choose either the Chinese or English version. Fill out the first page of the form with your basic information before the health check.*

(II) National Health Insurance

According to Taiwanese law, international students staying in Taiwan with an ARC for more than six months must enroll in National Health Insurance at their school or local district office. A person staying in Taiwan for six full months prescribed in enforcement rules of the NHI Act refers to a person who has, after entering into Taiwan, **stayed in Taiwan for six consecutive months or exited from Taiwan once for fewer than 30 days with the actual period of stay amounting to six months after the number of days that he or she has been away from Taiwan is deducted.**

International students with relatives who are an insured employee must enroll in the NHI program as dependents of the insured.

The National Health Insurance Program is mandatory; anyone who is eligible for the program must enroll. **Any qualified person who doesn't enroll is subject to a fine of NT\$3,000 to NT\$15,000.** In addition, this person is required to pay the full premiums starting from the date he or she should have been enrolled. No benefits will be offered before the premiums are paid in full. A notice of penalty violation will be delivered in writing and the fine must be paid on time. If the fines imposed remain unpaid, after a given period of time the case will be referred to the courts for compulsory enforcement.



VII. HEALTH CHECK AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

(III) How to apply for National Health Insurance IC Card?

A. International freshmen (including international students, overseas Chinese students and exchange students who came to Taiwan last year) can apply for a health insurance IC card after staying in Taiwan for more than six months. Please provide "one 2-inch photo", "photocopy of both front side and back side of ARC" and proof of low-income status (for overseas Chinese students) to the Discipline Section, Office Of Student Affairs.

B. New regulations stipulates that overseas Chinese students must provide "proof of low-income status in your country" to be qualified for health care benefits.

C. The date you may apply for a Health Insurance IC card:

The date you enter Taiwan + six months = the date you may apply if you did not exit from Taiwan + days you exit from Taiwan (you may only exit from Taiwan once for no more than 30 days)

► 2022/09/10(the date you enter Taiwan) + 6 (six months) = 2023/03/10 + 27 (assume that you exit from Taiwan for 27 days) --- the date you may apply is 2023/04/07

D. International students and Overseas Chinese students without proof of low-income status will be charged a premium of NT \$4,956 for six months ($826 * 6 = 4,956$)

Overseas Chinese students with proof of low-income status will be charged premium of a NT\$2,478 for six months ($413 * 6 = 2478$)



(IV) What to do if you lose your card?

If any changes are required or if you lose your NHI IC card, you may replace it by applying at any post office branch or at the Bureau of National Health Insurance. A 2-inch photo and a fee of NT \$200 are required.

(V) Medical services

After successfully applying for coverage under NHI, you will receive a NHI IC card. International students can use this card and ARC at NHI contracted hospitals and medical clinics around Taiwan. But the registration fee and part of the medical expenses are not included in NHI coverage. *List of NHI-contracted hospitals and medical clinics in Taitung County (City): Please refer to Attachment 1.*

VIII. SCHOLARSHIPS

(I) Types of scholarships (International Student)

(Please refer to “[Regulations for NTTU International Student Scholarships](#)”)

A. International Student Living Allowance Scholarship

NT\$ 5,000 per month during the course of their studies.

B. Scholarships for Newly-Admitted International Students

Students with Chinese language proficiency higher than or equivalent to *TOCFL B1* will be granted with full tuition and miscellaneous fee waivers for the academic year of the admission.

C. Outstanding Performance Scholarship for International Students

(A) Students who have achieved a grade point average in the *top 20 percent* of their college class in the previous academic year: *Will be granted with full tuition and miscellaneous fee waivers for the next academic year.*

(B) Students who have achieved a grade point average in the *top 50 percent* of their college class in the previous academic year: *Will be granted with half tuition and miscellaneous fee waivers for the next academic year.*

(C) *If the number of students in a Master's/PhD class is fewer than five*, the following rules shall apply:

- i. Students who achieved the *highest grade point average* in their college class in the previous academic year: *Will be granted with full tuition and miscellaneous fee waivers for the next academic year.*
- ii. Students who achieved the *second highest grade point average* in their college class in the previous academic year: *Will be granted with half tuition and miscellaneous fee waivers for the next academic year.*

D. Volunteer Scholarship

Awarded based on students' participation in service-learning activities, including language assistance, support for international exchange programs, student recruitment, and orientation services for new students.

E. Exchange Student Scholarship

Shall be conducted based on the principle of equality and reciprocity as agreed by both schools.

VIII. SCHOLARSHIPS

(II) How to apply for a scholarship?

A. Deadline

International students who enrolled in fall semester classes should submit an application before the end of September each year; international students who enrolled in spring semester classes should submit an application before the end of March each year. International students may submit a scholarship application along with the admission application.

B. Application qualifications

(A) Students who are in compliance with “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan” promulgated by the Ministry of Education and are admitted by NTTU as an enrolled overseas student (overseas Chinese students from Hong Kong and Macao, Mainland Chinese students, full-time workers and students who currently hold the nationality of the Republic of China (Taiwan) are excluded therefrom). Students who meet the conditions may, during the course of their studies in Taiwan, apply for NTTU’s “International Student Living Allowance Scholarship”, “Scholarships for Newly-Admitted International Students”, “Outstanding Performance Scholarship for International Students” and “Volunteer Scholarship”.

(B) Students who hold foreign nationality (overseas Chinese students from Hong Kong and Macao, Mainland Chinese students, full-time workers and students who currently hold the nationality of the Republic of China (Taiwan) are excluded therefrom) and are admitted by NTTU as an exchange student from any of our sister schools. Students who meet the conditions may, during the course of their studies in Taiwan, apply for “Volunteer Scholarship” and “Exchange Student Scholarship”.

(C) Exchange students: Exchange students of foreign nationality from universities that have an established academic collaboration agreement with NTTU or exchange students who have been recommended to study in NTTU by relevant academic institutions.

(D) Scholarship application procedure: Eligible applicants must submit the application via the Center of International Affairs to the "International Student Scholarships Review Committee" for review within the date announced.

The duration of the international student scholarship is 1 year each time. The applicant should submit an application every year for review. The total durations of scholarship is four years maximum for undergraduate students, two years maximum for graduate students, and four years maximum for doctoral students.

The scholarship shall be terminated if any of the following situations occurs:

(A) Suspension, drop out, transfer, graduation.

(B) The scholarship qualification should be revoked starting the following month of the notification if recipients are formally notified of being not allowed to sit for an exam, or are given a minor demerit or more serious punishment during the award period.

(C) Recipients found to have forged or provided false documents should be reviewed and revoked their scholarship qualification by the "International Student Scholarships Review Committee". The disqualified student shall return all the money received.

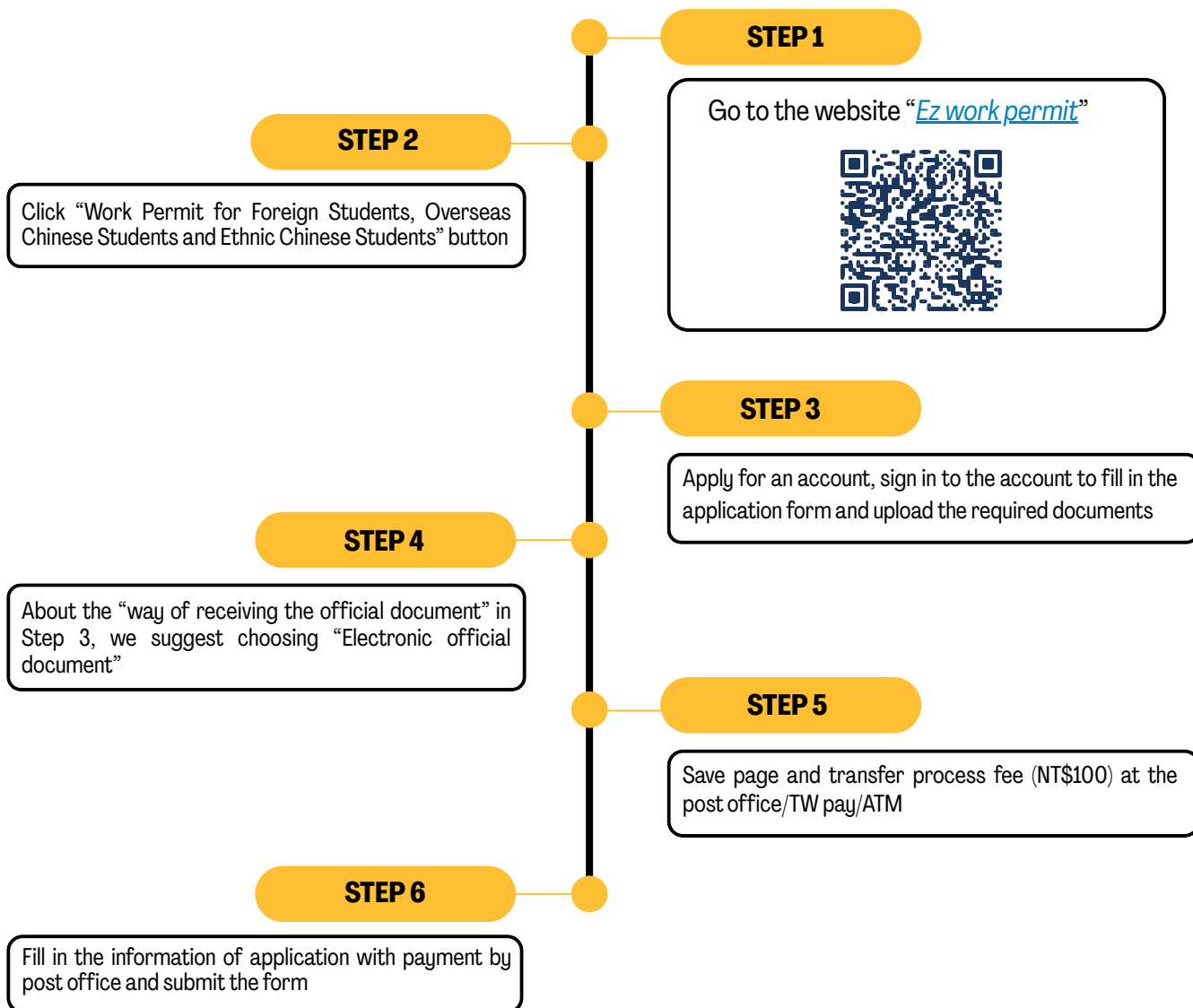

(III) How to open an account?

A. Opening a post office account

Please apply at a post office by providing a valid foreign passport and ARC.

Required documents:

- (A) Student ID card (original and photocopy of the front and back side).
- (B) ARC (original and photocopy of the front and back side).
- (C) Seal.

B. Opening a bank account

To open a bank account, you have to be at least 20 years old and provide the following documents:

- (A) Passport (with visa stamp of legal entry).
- (B) ARC.
- (C) Other proof of identity, such as Health insurance IC card, passport, driver's license or student ID card.
- (D) Seal.

To avoid being charged transaction fees, we recommend opening an account with one of the banks that partners with the university:

1. Chunghwa Post (A Taiwanese guarantor is required to open an account.)
2. Taiwan Cooperative Bank (No Taiwanese guarantor is required to open an account.)

IX. STUDENT LIFE INFORMATION

(V) Climate in Taitung

Eastern Taiwan is about 250 kilometers long. The Tropic of Cancer cutting across the island divides it into tropical and subtropical climate. Taitung basically has a tropical monsoon climate. The region's average summer temperature is about 27 degrees, but it often rise up to 30 degrees during the daytime. The temperature may be high, but being surrounded by high mountains and the sea, its climate is less sultry than that of metropolitan areas in western Taiwan. The average winter temperature is about 20 degrees. It may drop to about 12 degrees during a cold wave, but this doesn't happen very often.



Typhoon is one of the characteristics of Taitung's climate. Every July and August is the typhoon season. Since most typhoons develop in open waters near the Philippines, the eastern part of Taiwan will be the first to be affected. Therefore, summer often brings furious storms to Taitung. But western Taiwan is less affected thanks to the central mountain range that serves as a typhoon barrier.



Precipitation is quite abundant in eastern Taiwan, with an average annual precipitation up to 2,000 mm, but they are mostly heavy rain carried by typhoons during summer. There are not many rainy days in eastern Taiwan, especially in Taitung, which often has fine sunny weather ideal for travel.



- *Summer and autumn (April-November):* The temperature is around 25 degrees. July and August are the hottest months of the year with temperatures reaching up to 33 degrees and higher average precipitations.
- *Winter and spring (December-April):* The temperature is cooler with an average temperature around 20 degrees from December to February. It may drop to about 12 degrees during a cold wave.
